
Board of Directors' Elections


The following guide is for Access Credit Union members voting online at: accessvotes.ca

SCREEN 1: Click on "Cast My Vote".




SCREEN 2: Click on "I am a Representative of a Business or a Power of Attorney."



SCREEN 3:

Enter the business/power of attorney member number or business/power of attorney debit card number and business/power of attorney postal code.

Click **“Submit”**.






Members can find their member number as follows:


SCREEN 6:

To continue, click **“Next”**.




SCREEN 7:

Voter Eligibility

GENERAL VOTING GUIDELINES

- Must be a member – one share one vote.
- Must be over the age of 18 years.

VOTING ON BEHALF OF A CORPORATION OR ASSOCIATION

Corporate Resolution – Business members, including partnerships, non-profits, and sole proprietorships/doing business as, must appoint a representative to cast a vote on behalf of the organization. Corporate resolutions submitted for past votes remain in effect until they are canceled or revoked in writing by the Company/Association.

In accordance with the voting notice, all Corporate Resolutions were to be received by Wednesday, March 11, 2026 at 12:00 p.m.

PROXY VOTING

- Not permitted

TRUST ACCOUNTS

- Not eligible for voting

ESTATE ACCOUNTS

- Not eligible for voting

POWERS OF ATTORNEY

- Powers of attorney may vote on behalf of another member if the Credit Union has received a copy of the power of attorney document and the document specifies that they may vote on behalf of the Member.

NEW MEMBERSHIPS AND VOTING ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible to vote, the membership share must have been opened no later than March 4, 2026.

MINORS' VOTING RIGHTS

- No member under the age of 18 may vote.
